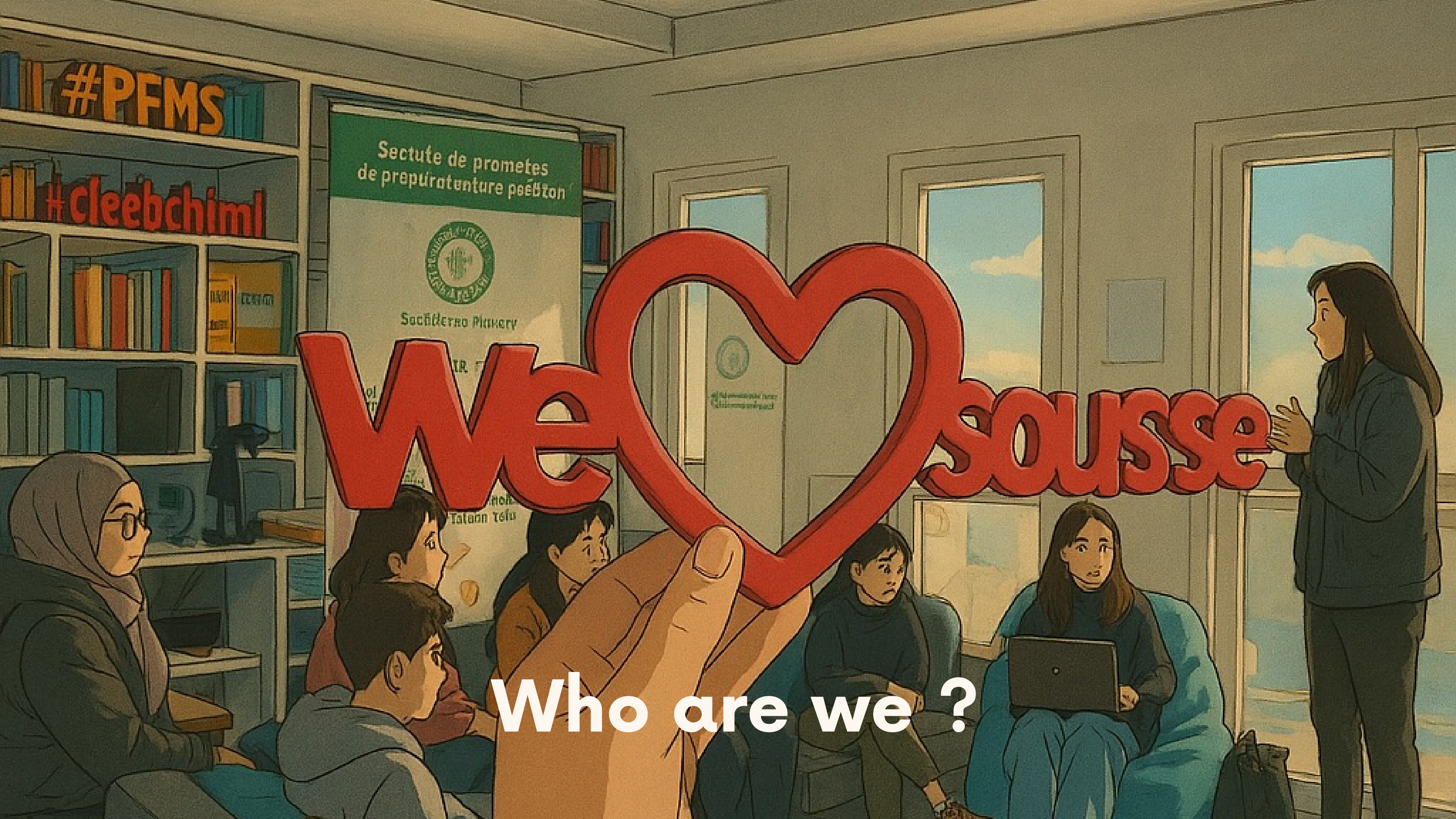

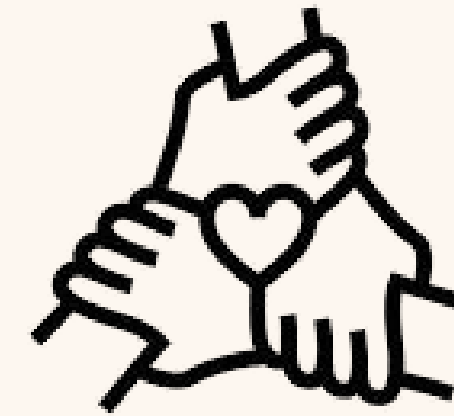
Mission

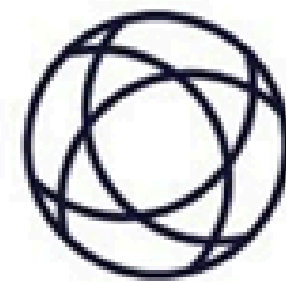

GreenLab



The We Love Sousse Solidarity Nursery Plant is a collaborative space located in Errayhane Park, in the heart of the Ezzouhour district. Designed as a place for community engagement and collaboration, it brings together young people, women, volunteers and local stakeholders around social, cultural, environmental and solidarity initiatives.



Cultural Lab

The Cultural Lab by We Love Sousse is a space dedicated to creativity, cultural exchange and experimentation.

It hosts several clubs, including: theatre, music, literature, English, anthropology and mental health.

It provides young people and association members with opportunities to learn, express themselves and develop cultural projects.

The Cultural Lab aims to foster collaboration, promote local talent and enrich the cultural life of the community.



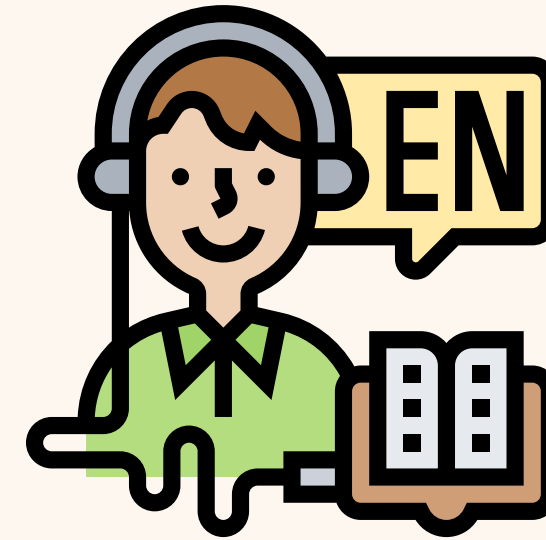

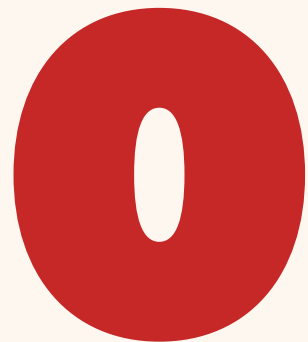


The 3ZERO Campus Club Tunisia, coordinated by We Love Sousse, is part of the global 3ZERO Initiative.

It is a university club that raises awareness among students about global challenges while encouraging civic engagement.

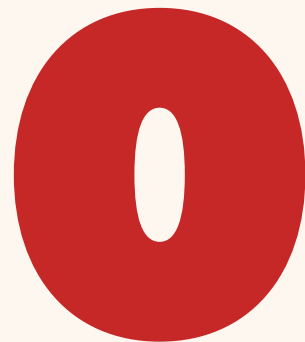

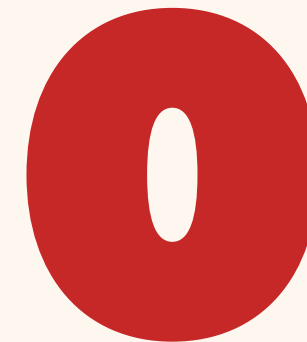

International Cooperation

UN75 Forum

The UN75 Global Governance Forum is an initiative linked to the 75th anniversary of the United Nations.

Its objective is to gather recommendations from civil society to help shape the UN's priorities for the next 75 years.

As part of this initiative, conferences were organized in South Africa, Estonia and Tunisia. The conference held in Sousse was organized by We Love Sousse and brought together 80 participants from 8 countries, contributing to a set of recommendations submitted to the United Nations.



3ZERO Convergence Forum

The 3ZERO Convergence Forum is part of an international initiative led by ACTED to promote the Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE) through conferences, workshops and project fairs highlighting initiatives with social and environmental impact.

In Tunisia, the event is co-organized by We Love Sousse, bringing together NGOs, social entrepreneurs and committed young people to encourage collaboration, exchange ideas and support the development of innovative SSE projects.





We Love Sousse Activities

Cultural Activity: Women's Voices

A 100% female artistic performance bringing together young artists from across the Mediterranean region.

Cultural Activity: Bab Bhar Festival

A festival held in Boujaafar, Sousse, as part of a Tunisian-Egyptian partnership.

First Edition

2015, launched in response to the terrorist attack.

The festival included an exhibition featuring artisans committed to fighting corruption.



Cultural Activity: Shoot As You Walk

An activity designed for photography enthusiasts

Objectives :

- **Showcase the beauty of the city, its architecture and its streets.**
- **Encourage creativity and observation.**

Each photo walk is followed by a discussion and the selection of the best photograph.



Humanitarian Activity: For Our Children

An initiative providing school supplies to children from disadvantaged backgrounds.

Objectives :

- **Support children from vulnerable families in their education.**
- **Reduce inequalities in access to school supplies.**
- **Encourage educational success and school retention.**



Humanitarian Activity: Koffet Romdhane

Collection and distribution of food baskets to families in need.

➔ 627 food baskets were distributed last year.

- **Support vulnerable families during the month of Ramadan.**
- **Help reduce food insecurity.**
- **Promote solidarity and mutual support within the community.**
